

Bibliographie wissenschaftlicher Literatur zum chinesischen Recht des Jahres 2002

Die Einführung einer jährlich erscheinenden Bibliographie hat das Ziel, den Lesern des NEWSLETTER einen raschen Überblick über die Themen zu geben, welche in der rechtswissenschaftlichen Literatur zum chinesischen Recht eines Jahrganges en vogue waren. In der vorliegenden Bibliographie wurden nur Artikel in Fachzeitschriften, Beiträge in Sammelbänden, Monographien und Sammelbände berücksichtigt, die in deutscher und englischer Sprache erschienen sind.

Im Hinblick auf die deutschsprachige Literatur wurden die Hefte 1-12 der Zeitschrift „Karlsruher Juristische Bibliographie“ (KJB) des Jahres 2002 zu Themen ausgewertet, die sich mit dem chinesischen Recht beschäftigen. Zugleich dient die systematische Einordnung juristischer Arbeiten der KJB auch als Vorbild für die Gliederung der vorliegenden Bibliographie nach Sachgebieten (vgl. zur Sachübersicht und systematischen Einordnung einzelner Themen die Umschlagseiten 3 und 4 in jedem Heft der KJB).
